




Groundwater Flood Depth

Indicative Groundwater flood depth

-  Groundwater levels are at least 5m below the ground surface.
-  Groundwater levels are between 0.5m and 5m below the ground surface.
-  Groundwater levels are between 0.025m and 0.5m below the ground surface.
-  Groundwater levels are either at or very near (within 0.025m of) the ground surface.
-  Low risk.

**Notes**  
The map provides an indicative assessment of groundwater flood hazard on a 5m grid. Please refer to Section 4 of the SFCA Report for further detail of the dataset used to define the potential for groundwater emergence.  
The map shows the flood risk data and information based on the map title and legend. If no data is displayed on the map, or not all features are present, this indicates that the respective flood source or features are not present within this area.



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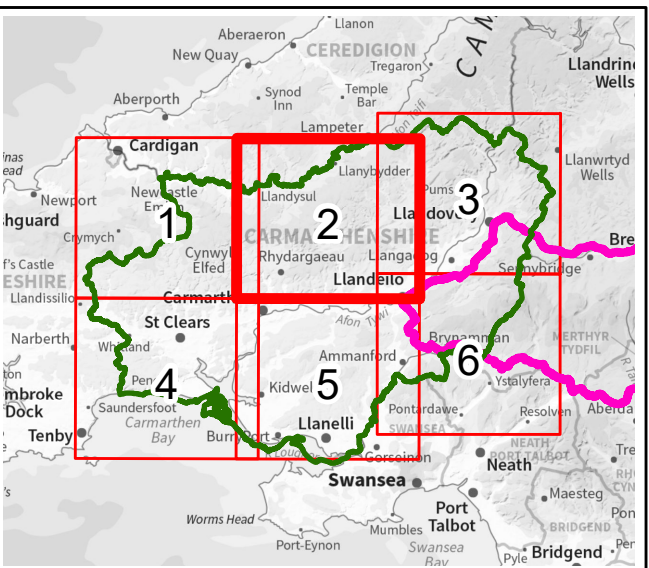
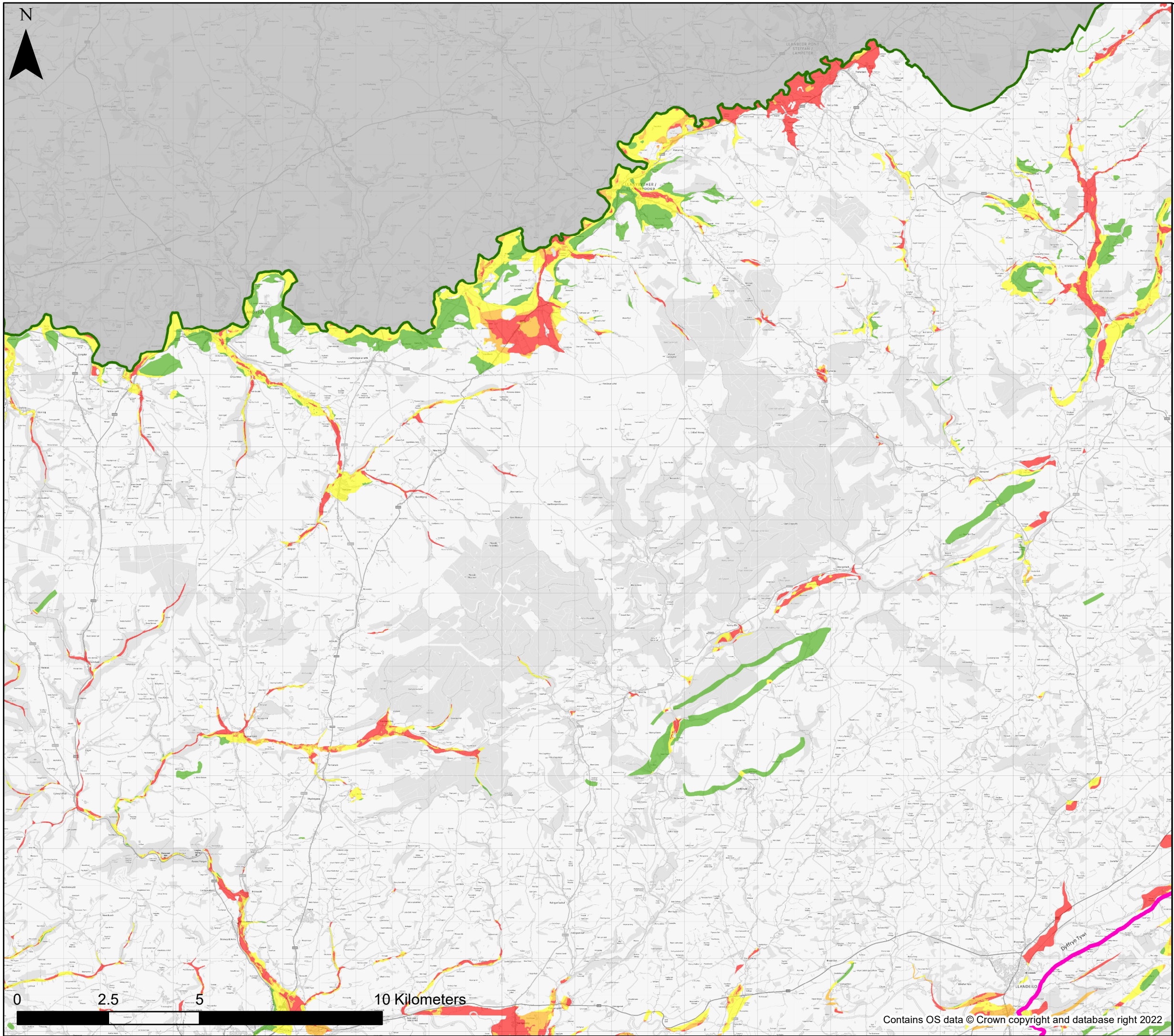
