

STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURE FOR ACTIVE TRAVEL PURPOSES –

JUNCTION OF PICTON TERRACE AND THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE TOWN PARK, CARMARTHEN

Carmarthenshire County Council intends to introduce a flat-top raised plateau road hump on the access road leading to the town park, centred at a location approximately four (4) metres south of its junction with Picton Terrace in Carmarthen.

Carmarthenshire County Council considers the measure to be necessary in the interests of road safety, by:

- a) making it easier and safer for pedestrians and cyclists to cross by eliminating the height difference to the carriageway; and
- b) slowing down turning traffic and encouraging vehicular traffic to give way, thereby prioritising pedestrian safety.
