**THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (CARMARTHEN) SPECIAL PARKING
AREA (RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION NO. 2) ORDER 2011**

The Carmarthenshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with the Road Traffic Act 1991, hereby make the following Order:-

The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Special Parking Area (Residents Parking Places) Order 2004 ("the Order") is hereby varied by the attachment thereto of the plans attached to this Order which has the effect of imposing on such parts of the roads identified and for the periods identified in the plans attached to this Order:

1. Provision of resident parking places.
2. Revocation of "The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Special Parking Area (Residents Parking Places) Order 2004 insofar as it relates to Article 7 "and who can show that he needs the use of a vehicle for the efficient conduct of his or their business and not solely to enable an individual or individuals to travel conveniently to or from his or their place of work".
3. Revocation of "The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 insofar as it relates to the sides of road specified in this Order in accordance with the provisions of the Order.

The Order shall come into operation on the 9th day of September 2011 and maybe cited as The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Special Parking Area (Residents Parking Places) Variation No. 2) Order 2011.

PUBLIC NOTICE

**THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (CARMARTHEN) SPECIAL PARKING AREA
(RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES)(VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 2010**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Carmarthenshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order will be to amend The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Special Parking Area (Residents Parking Places) Order 2004 ("the Order") by substituting the plans annexed thereto denoting zones C1 and C5 with the plans annexed to the Order. The consequence of the amendment will:

1. Provide resident parking places with charges in parts of the roads listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on all days except Sunday. During such days and hours of operation the Order will prohibit parking along such parts of the said roads except for vehicles displaying a valid parking permit issued by Carmarthenshire County Council.
2. Revoke "The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Special Parking Area (Residents Parking Places) Order 2004" insofar as it relates to Article 7

'and who can show that he needs the use of a vehicle for the efficient conduct of his or their business and not solely to enable an individual or individuals to travel conveniently to or from his or their place of work'

3. Revoke The County of Carmarthenshire (Carmarthen) Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 insofar as it relates to the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice

The provisions for the usual exemptions contained in the Order will apply in relation to the roads referred to in paragraphs 1 above. These include the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties situated adjacent to such parts of the roads affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order contains the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme and for motor cycles.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with the plans annexed thereto showing the parts of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Customer Services Centre, 3 Spilman Street, Carmarthen during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Lyn Thomas, Head of Administration and Law by the 17th day of February, 2011.

HYSBYSIR trwy hyn fod Cyngor Sir Caerfyrddin yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn dan Adrannau 45, 46, 49, 53 a 124 a Rhan IV o Atodlen 9 Deddf Rheoli Traffig Ffyrrd 1984 fel y'i diwygiwyd a Deddf Traffig Ffyrrd 1991 a phob pŵer galluogi arall.

Canlyniadau'r newid arfaethedig fydd:

1. Darparu llefydd parcio i breswylwyr ar rannau o'r ffyrdd a restrir yn Atodlen 1 yr Hysbysiad hwn rhwng 8.00a.m. a 6.00p.m. ar bob diwrnod heblaw am ddydd Sul. Yn ystod y cyfryw ddyddiau ac oriau bydd y Gorchymyn yn gwahardd parcio ar hyd y rhannau hynny o'r ffyrdd dan sylw ar wahân i gerbydau sy'n arddangos hawlen barcio ddilys a gyhoeddwyd gan Gyngor Sir Caerfyrddin.
2. Dirymu "Gorchymyn Sir Gaerfyrddin (Caerfyrddin) Ardal Barcio Arbennig (Llefudd Parcio i Breswylwyr) 2004" i'r graddau y mae'n berthnasol i Erthygl 7 'ac sy'n gallu dangos bod arno/arni/arnynt angen defnyddio cerbyd er mwyn cynnal ei fusnes / ei busnes / eu busnes yn effeithiol ac nid dim ond er mwyn galluogi unigolyn neu unigolion i deithio'n gyfleus yn ôl ac ymlaen i'r gwaith' (cyfeithiad)
3. Dirymu "Gorchymyn Cydgyfnerthu Sir Gaerfyrddin (Caerfyrddin) Cyfngiadau ar Aros a Llefudd Parcio ar y Stryd 2004" i'r graddau y mae'n berthnasol i'r ochrau ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 2 yr Hysbysiad hwn.

Bydd darpariaethau'r eithriadau arferol yn y Gorchymyn yn gymwys at y ffyrdd y cyfeirir atynt ym mharagraff 1 uchod. Mae'r rhain yn cynnwys hawl teithwyr i esgyn i gerbyd neu ddisgyn ohono, ynghyd â llwytho neu ddadlwytho nwyddau, cyflawni gwaith adeiladu a gwaith arall, cyflawni pwerau neu ddyletswyddau statudol a leolir ger y rhannau hynny o'r ffordd yr effeithir arnynt gan y cyfngiad arfaethedig.


